Server / Logging machine

Hardware

1.0 GHz Pentium 4
256 MB RAM
Minimum 40 GB Hard Disk (80 GB recommended)
CD-ROM Drive
Minimum SVGA Graphics (XGA recommended)
Network Card

Depending on your source of the call data, your system may require additional hardware.

- Most legacy switches output to Serial port, but its more common in newer switches to be able to collect via IP over the network.
- If you are collecting from remote buffer boxes etc, then you will have to have a Oak approved remote buffer box device.
